### **Introduction**

StackForce Inc. ("**StackForce**" or "**We**") respects your privacy and are committed to protecting it through our compliance with this policy.

This policy describes the types of information we may collect from you or that you may provide when you visit the website [www.stackforce.com](http://www.stackforce.com) (our "**Website**") and use any services provided through the Website (the "**Services**") and our practices for collecting, using, maintaining, protecting, and disclosing that information.

This policy applies to information we collect:

- Through the Website or Services.
- In email, text, and other electronic messages between you and the Website and Services.
- When you interact with our advertising and applications on third-party websites and services, if those applications or advertising include links to this policy.

It does not apply to information collected by:

- us offline or through any other means, including on any other website operated by StackForce or any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries); or
- any third party (including our affiliates and subsidiaries), including through any application or content (including advertising) that may link to or be accessible from, on, or through the Website or the Services.

Please read this policy carefully to understand our policies and practices regarding your information and how we will treat it. If you do not agree with our policies and practices, your choice is not to use our Website or Services. By accessing or using this Website and the Services, you agree to this privacy policy. This policy may change from time to time (see [Changes to Our Privacy Policy](#)). Your continued use of this Website and the Services after we make changes is deemed to be acceptance of those changes, so please check the policy periodically for updates.

### **Children Under the Age of 13**

Our Website and Services are not intended for children under 13 years of age. No one under age 13 may provide any information to or on the Website or through the Services. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13. If you are under 13, do not use or provide any information on this Website or on or through any of its Services, register on the Website or Services, make any purchases through the Website or Services, use any of the interactive or public comment features of this Website or Services, or provide any information about yourself to us, including your name, address, telephone number, email address, or any screen name or user name you may use. If we learn we have collected or received personal information from a child under 13 without verification of parental consent, we will delete that information. ### **Information We Collect About You and How We Collect It**

We collect several types of information from and about users of our Website and Services, including information:

- by which you may be personally identified, such as name, postal address, e-mail address, telephone number, skills and work experience, credit/debit or other financial account information, or any other identifier by which you may be contacted online or offline ("**personal information**");
- that is about you but individually does not identify you, such as geographic information, passwords, etc.; and
- about your internet connection, the equipment you use to access our Website and Services and usage details.

We collect this information:

- Directly from you when you provide it to us.
- Automatically as you navigate through the site. Information collected automatically may include usage details, IP addresses, and information collected through cookies, web beacons, and other tracking technologies.
- From third parties, for example, our business partners.

### ***Information You Provide to Us***

The information we collect on or through our Website and Services may include:

- Information that you provide by filling in forms on our Website. This includes information provided at the time of registering to use our Website or Services, subscribing to our Services, posting material, or requesting further services. We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our Website or Services.
- Records and copies of your correspondence (including email addresses), if you contact us.
- Details of transactions you carry out through our Website and Services and of the fulfillment of your orders. You may be required to provide financial information before placing an order through our Website or Services.
- Your search queries on the Website.

You also may provide information to be published or displayed (hereinafter, "**posted**") on public areas of the Website, or transmitted to other users of the Website or Services or third parties (collectively, "**User Contributions**"). Your User Contributions are posted on and transmitted to others at your own risk. Additionally, we cannot control the actions of other users of the Website or Services with whom you may choose to share your User Contributions. Therefore, we cannot and do not guarantee that your User Contributions will not be viewed by unauthorized persons.

### ***Information We Collect Through Automatic Data Collection Technologies***

As you navigate through and interact with our Website and use our Services, we may use automatic data collection technologies to collect certain information about your equipment, browsing actions, and patterns, including:

- Details of your visits to our Website, including traffic data, location data, logs, and other communication data and the resources that you access and use on the Website or through the Services.

- Information about your computer and internet connection, including your IP address, operating system, and browser type.

We also may use these technologies to collect information about your online activities over time and across third-party websites or other online services (behavioral tracking). Due to the lack of standards for how Do Not Track consumer browser settings should work on commercial websites, our Website does not respond to Do Not Track browser settings.

The information we collect automatically may include personal information or we may maintain it or associate it with personal information we collect in other ways or receive from third parties. It helps us to improve our Website and to deliver a better and more personalized service, including by enabling us to:

- Estimate our audience size and usage patterns.
- Store information about your preferences, allowing us to customize our Website according to your individual interests.
- Speed up your searches.
- Recognize you when you return to our Website.

The technologies we use for this automatic data collection may include:

- **Cookies (or browser cookies).** A cookie is a small file placed on the hard drive of your computer. You may refuse to accept browser cookies by activating the appropriate setting on your browser. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Website or Services. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you direct your browser to our Website.
- **Web Beacons.** Pages of our the Website may contain small electronic files known as web beacons (also referred to as clear gifs, pixel tags, and single-pixel gifs) that permit StackForce, for example, to count users who have visited those pages or for other related statistics (for example, recording the popularity of certain content and verifying system and server integrity).
- **Google Analytics.** We use a tool called "Google Analytics" to collect information about use of this Website. Google Analytics collects information such as how often users visit this Website, what pages they visit when they do so, and what other sites they used prior to coming to this Website. We use the information we get from Google Analytics only to improve this Website. Google Analytics collects only the IP address assigned to you on the date you visit this Website, rather than your name or other identifying information. We do not combine the information collected through the use of Google Analytics with personally identifiable information. Although Google Analytics plants a permanent cookie on your web browser to identify you as a unique user the next time you visit this Website, the cookie cannot be used by anyone but Google. Google's ability to use and share information collected by Google Analytics about your visits to this site is restricted by the Google Analytics Terms of Use and the Google Privacy Policy. You can prevent Google Analytics from recognizing you on return visits to this site by disabling cookies on your browser.

- To present our Website and its contents to you.

- To carry out our obligations and enforce our rights arising from any contracts entered into between you and us, including for billing and collection.
- To notify you about changes to our Website or Services.
- To allow you to participate in interactive features on our Website.
- In any other way we may describe when you provide the information.
- For any other purpose with your consent.
